

Our Lord explained to Lucia (visionary of the blessed Virgin Mary in Fatima, Portugal in the year of 1917) why He seeks five Saturdays of reparation.

- Make a good Confession (within 8 or so days before or after the First Saturday)

- Pray five decades of the Holy Rosary 3.
