

The Shock of Fr. Arul's Murder

There aren't any adequate words to adequately respond to the murder of Fr. Arul.

I imagine many of you are experiencing what I am: it doesn't seem real, and it hasn't sunk in yet, especially for those of you who had a more personal connection with him.

Fr. Arul was a tremendous blessing to me as I transitioned into the area and into my role as a pastor for the first time. Even the day before he passed, I was seeking his counsel on parish matters because he had a deep wisdom when it came to loving and governing his flock. I knew he always had my back and would drop anything to be a support for me in difficulty, because he did that for me multiple times.

Most importantly, he loved Jesus and loved being a priest, especially bringing the Eucharist to his flock.

In his almost 14 years at Saints Peter and Paul, he told me he had buried well over 400 people and had baptized just as many. He was a priest for his people, especially in their suffering, grief, and dying. I jokingly say he knew people's extended family and relatives better than they did!

Be assured of my prayers and support for you as we go through this together.

Thank you for the outpouring and love you have already shown me and my brother priests of this region...right now, we don't need anything more than your commitment to pray for us, our community, and yourselves, that we would all draw closer to the pierced Heart of Jesus in this time.

Remember, Jesus' resurrection has guaranteed the final victory over death and evil...revival is underway and speeds ahead through the blood of our martyrs!
