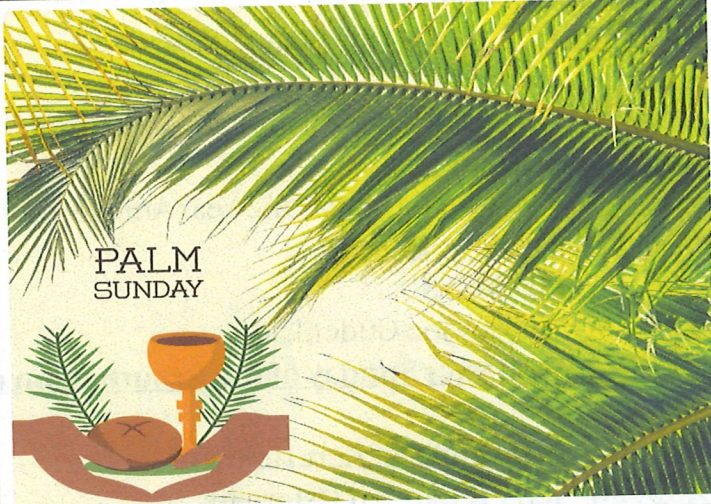

## The Most Important Week of the Year!

What a gift to be entering into the holiest, most important week of the year for us as Christians! Without the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus, our faith has no purpose or power. *This week will have extra significance and opportunities for prayer and healing as we remember the tragic death of Fr. Arul on April 3rd, which providentially lines up with Good Friday this year.*

If Jesus did rise from the dead, as we profess to believe, this changes everything, especially in the face of a tragedy like we had last year. We can live already now with confidence that Jesus is with us every moment, though we may not feel Him, and He will escort us from this life into perfect, loving union with Him, the Father, and the Holy Spirit in the next!

Please don't miss the opportunity to join in the most important liturgies of the year and these extra prayer opportunities that happen before Easter Sunday:

### Holy Thursday - 7pm Mass

This Mass includes remembrance of Jesus washing the feet of his apostles, the institution of the Eucharist/the priesthood, and a procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the side altar to commemorate Jesus' agony in the garden before being arrested.
