Bless My Business!

This upcoming, Friday, May 1, we celebrate St. Joseph the Worker to begin the month of Mary (my favorite month of the year!).

In her rich tradition, the Church has taught the great value of work, not just because of what we produce for society but because

- 1. we ourselves become "co-workers" with God who is THE Creator**
- 2. and we are transformed by our labors when we invite God into them**

It is interesting to note that in the garden of Eden, Adam is commissioned to work and have dominion over creation even before he fell and the work became painful. Work was not intended to be a punishment; it was part of God's original plan!

We naturally tend to separate the different areas of our life: work/finances here, home/family there, and God at Church. In reality, God is supposed to be the foundation of every aspect of our life. He has a plan for every part of the day-to-day, and through our intentional times of prayer, we start to be with Him at every moment of the day!

In order to help us invite God into the other aspects of our life, especially the work place, **I would love to come to your place of work (if your boss/coworkers are agreeable to this) and bless it as a place where God and His Will is welcomed.** Wherever God is invited, He comes. Be aware, though, if you invite Him in, He will want to be THE boss. Fortunately, when we let Him be in charge, things to work out better for everyone anyway! :)

If you would be interested in me coming by for a brief blessing, a simple prayer and sprinkling of holy water, fill out this little form that is linked, and I will try to organize it so I can visit multiple places in the same area at a time. Keep in mind that if many people respond, it may take more than a few weeks for me to make all of the stops!

I look forward to inviting God to be at the center of your workplace so that it can be a place where we are transformed and bring glory to Him and not ourselves!
