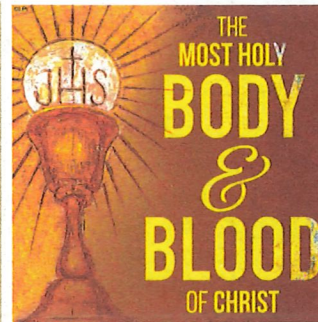

The Gift of Receiving the Eucharist

This weekend, we celebrate the incomprehensible gift of Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity truly Present in the Most Holy Eucharist.

I appreciate the many kind affirmations that you have given me for the reverence that I try to show our Lord in the Mass. I take the Eucharist very seriously because everything that we believe in Catholics revolves around His True Presence. If that isn't true, everything else in our Catholic faith comes crashing down, and I am wasting my time being a priest who offers the Mass day after day.

Personally, I don't always have warm feelings or sensible devotion in my heart during the Mass, which is why I try to move more slowly and reverently to let my heart and mind catch up with what my body is doing and the words that I am saying.

Here are a few suggestions for how we might cultivate a deeper spirit of reverence and greater appreciation for this tremendous Gift that is the Eucharist.

Please note: You are not obliged to do any of these nor are you judged for not doing them; I have just found these practices to be conducive for a prayerful disposition around the Eucharist

1. I love how many people come early to Mass here at this parish! Come early, read the readings beforehand, spend some time in silence, or join in the rosary. It will absolutely help you enter into Mass with more recollection.
2. Take an extra moment as you genuflect facing toward the tabernacle to remember that He is actually there in front of you.
3. Regardless of whether you receive the Eucharist on the hand or on the tongue, standing or kneeling, approach that moment of union with Jesus with slower, intentional movements, resisting the "grab-and-go" tendency that we can drift into.
4. In addition to praying in silence after communion, thanking Jesus for this gift of Himself, the Church also recommends spending additional moments or minutes with Him after Mass is concluded.* Obviously, sometimes we do have a time crunch before our next commitment, but if not, please consider staying with Him for a little extra time and not rushing out the door. Even if you aren't staying to pray, please exit the church with reverence and low voices, maintaining a quiet atmosphere for those who do wish to keep praying.

Regardless of how we approach the Eucharist, please resist the enemy's temptation to look down on others for how they apparently show reverence or not.

May our parish be a place where every visitor here will say, after looking at how we approach Jesus in the Eucharist, "Wow, these people love their Lord in the Eucharist, and it is clear that they truly believe He is here!"

Enthronement

The center of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the Enthronement of the image of the Sacred Heart in the home. By the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart, we link the tabernacle of our parish church to our home, inviting our Lord to be a constant and most intimate companion. The Enthronement is a way of life. It means that Christ is King of our hearts, and we desire Him to be present with us always.

Preparation

Day 1: To the Heart of Our King : "Jesus of Bethlehem"

Scripture : 3rd Joyful Mystery : Birth of Jesus in the Stable Luke 2:1-20

Prayer : Decade of the Rosary &/or Litany of the Sacred Heart

Discuss : See Jesus being adored as King by His parents, the shepherds & the 3 Kings.

Gaze at the image of the Sacred Heart. What does it mean to me, and what does it make me think as I pray with the image? (Suggest getting image blessed at this time as well!)

Day 2: To the Heart of Our Brother : "Jesus of Nazareth"

Scripture : 5th Joyful Mystery : The Finding of Jesus in the Temple Luke 2:40-52

Prayer : Decade of the Rosary &/or Litany of the Sacred Heart

Discuss : Jesus, the son of God, lived an ordinary life in the little home in Nazareth with

Mary and Joseph. Consider where the image is being placed. This is His home in our space, how can I make a throne for His Heart in mine?

Day 3: To the Heart of Our Friend : "Jesus of Bethany"

Scripture : 1st Glorious Mystery : The Resurrection John 11:1-27

Prayer : Decade of the Rosary &/or Litany of the Sacred Heart

Discuss : See Jesus rising in triumph from the tomb and hear Him promising Mary and

Martha that their brother will rise again. Lord, help me not to pass by the image with blindness or hurry. How can I acknowledge and recommit myself to You?

Ceremony

Priest | Deacon | Head of Family Presides

Introduction

Lead: "God is Love" (1 John 4:16) and all of His works serve to show this divine love to mankind. In the writings of the Old Testament, God's love created us in His image and likeness; it established a covenant with Abraham; and it rescued the chosen people from slavery in Egypt and brought them to the Promised Land. The fullest expression of God's love is the person of Jesus Christ: "God so loved the world that he gave His only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). The Heart of Jesus itself, in love with and wounded for mankind, is the most perfect symbol of the love of God. For this reason, "The prayer of the Church venerates and honors the Heart of Jesus.... It adores the Incarnate Word and His Heart which, out of love for men, He allowed to be pierced by our sins" (CCC 2669).

The Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, for which we are gathered, is an expression of our own love of God and the love which He shows to us. "The enthroned image of the Sacred Heart expresses the true Kingship of Christ who rules over us by giving up His life for us. It daily reminds each member of the family to follow in Christ's royal way by making reparation for sins committed and by striving to serve God and neighbor more lovingly. The image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is enthroned to signify that Christ is He Who gives inspiration and direction to each member of the family. The Enthronement is a single act, but it represents a way of life by which each member of the family is transformed in Christ each day" (Archbishop Raymond Leo Burke).

May the Enthronement truly be for this family a source of new vigor in living the Christian vocation, the vocation of love.

Apostles Creed

Reading by Member of Family

Options: 1 John 4:7-16; Luke 1:26-33; Luke 19:1-10; Luke 10:38-41

Homily or Family Discussion/Reflection

12 Promises of the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state in life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of Mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to Priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance - they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments. My Heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

Renewal of Your Consecration

The consecration should be renewed annually. Some suggested dates are: Feast of the Sacred Heart; Feast of Christ the King; June - the month of the Sacred Heart; Anniversaries and other dates of significance to the family.

Daily Offering:

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You my prayers, works, joys and sufferings of this day in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, reparation for sins, the reunion of all Christians; I offer them for the intentions of our Bishops and of all Apostles of Prayer and in particular for those recommended by our Holy Father this month.

Daily Prayer to Sacred Heart:

Dear Sacred Heart of Jesus, we renew our pledge of love and loyalty to You. Keep us always close to Your loving Heart and to the most pure Heart of Your Mother. May we love one another more and more each day, forgiving each other's faults as You forgive us our sins. Teach us to see You in the members of our family and those we meet outside our home, and to love them, especially the poor and oppressed, that we may be instrumental in bringing about justice and peace. Please help us to carry our cross daily out of love for You, and to strengthen this love by frequent Mass and Communion. Thank you dear Jesus, King and Friend of our family, for all the blessings of this day. Protect us and all families during this night. Help us so to live that we may all get heaven.

Act of Enthronement

Head Carries Image & another member a Bible; candles optional: all process to place of Enthronement

Lead: I now enthrone Jesus as King and Friend of our family.

Place image in place, with Bible near it.

We are nourished by the Body and Blood of Christ, and the Word of God.

All: "God is Enthroned as King forever!" (Ps 29) "All that the Lord has said we will heed and do." (Exodus 24:7)

Act of Consecration of the Family

Kneel and say in unison

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, who made known to St. Margaret Mary Your great desire to reign over Christian families, we are gathered here today to proclaim Your complete rule over our family. From now on we promise to lead a Christ-like life: we will strive to develop in our home all the virtues which bring with them the peace that You promised. And we will not compromise with the spirit of secularism which You have strongly denounced. You will rule over our minds through our deep and living faith. You will be King of our hearts by our generous love for You; and we will cultivate this love by the frequent reception of You in Holy Communion. Divine Heart of Jesus, preside over our family gatherings; bless all our family undertakings, both spiritual and temporal. Sanctify our joys and comfort us in our sorrows. And if any member of our family should have the misfortune to offend Your seriously, remind him, O Sacred Heart of Jesus, of Your infinite love and mercy for the penitent sinner. And when the hour of separation comes, when death brings its sorrows into our family, whether we go or whether we stay, we will humbly accept Your divine will. And at the same time we will console and comfort ourselves with the thought that the time will come when our whole family will be united lovingly with You in heaven forever. There we shall sing a hymn of praise to the infinite mercy and love of Your Sacred Heart. We ask the Immaculate Heart of Mary and our glorious protector, St. Joseph, to offer You this family consecration. May the memory of this consecration be with us always. Glory to the Divine Heart of Jesus, Our King and our Father! Praise to the Divine Heart of Jesus that brought us salvation. To It be honor and glory forever. Amen.

Intercessions

Lead: Lord, Jesus, You told us that "whatever you ask the Father in my name, He will give to you." In your name, and with great confidence in Your love, we now offer these prayer:
