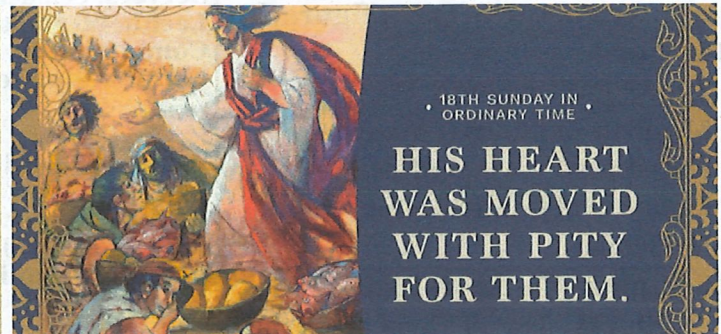

Why do I have to go to Mass on Sunday?

I imagine many of us have experienced confusion or lack of understanding around the "Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation" that we have as Catholics.

Canon 1247 of the Code of Canon Law (the official law of the Catholic Church) states:

On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass; they are also to abstain from those labors and business concerns which impede the worship to be rendered to God, the joy which is proper to the Lord's Day, or the proper relaxation of mind and body.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church further explains in paragraph 2181:

The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. 119 Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin.

Here are a few other reasons why it is required for us to participate in the gift of the Mass every week:

1. Entering into rest

It fulfills God's commandment to keep holy the Sabbath day. God doesn't give us commands for His sake but for ours. He knows we need to take a break from the day-to-day things to focus on our relationship with Him and others because we naturally start to drift away over time.

2. Giving God thanks

Mass is the most important thing that we can do to give Him thanks for the gift of our lives and all our blessings. "Eucharist" means thanksgiving because we participate in the thanksgiving sacrifice that Jesus offers to the Father.

3. Being a part of the community

Receiving the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist is super important, but even if we can't receive communion because we are not in a state of grace or haven't observed the hour fast before communion time, it is still important to be physically present with others in offering worship and sacrifice to God. Similarly, family meals and holidays aren't the same with loved ones missing that could have been there!

This requirement outlined here also has a few other practical consequences that I don't believe we have always clearly communicated as a church.

Here are a few of those:

1. We must still attend Mass when we are on vacation or out of town for other reasons. Please plan your trips with practicing your faith first in mind!
2. Watching Mass online does not fulfill your Sunday obligation if you are healthy and able to travel.
3. Going to Mass on another day of the week does not substitute for a missed Sunday Obligation.
4. Participating in a communion service (for example, at an assisted living home or other institution) also does not fulfill your obligation if you are healthy and able to travel to a local Mass
5. If we deliberately miss Mass when we are healthy, able to travel, and not under constraints out of our control, we need to go to confession before receiving the Eucharist at the next Mass.

****Important Exceptions:**

*For health care and emergency service workers that do not have the flexibility to attend Mass on Saturday night or the Sunday times available, they are dispensed from attending Mass like the sick and homebound but must still devote time, ideally at least a half hour, to our Lord as soon as they are able. Watching Sunday Mass online, attending a communion service, and praying with the Sunday readings would be legitimate options for this group in contrast to those who are able to attend Mass in person.***

I hope it is clear that I only make these kinds of clarifications so that all of my parishioners can be properly informed to exercise their faith to the full.

As with all these kinds of teachings, I have no intention of shaming anyone who has knowingly or unknowingly not followed these guidelines of the Church. We are all sinners in need of repentance, and we have a Savior in Jesus who loves to forgive us every time we come back to Him with humble hearts.

Please receive this as a sign of my love and not as condemnation of you or your loved ones. I sincerely want what is best for all of you!

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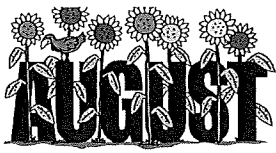
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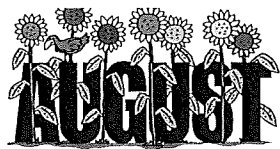
