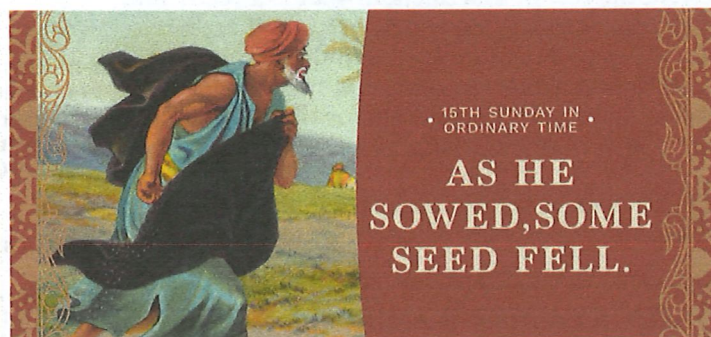

A note from Fr. Joel on Mass Intentions

I apologize for any times that I have neglected to say the Mass intention of the day or for any times that the incorrect Mass intention has been said.

Please know that I offer Mass for whatever the intention listed in the bulletin is, even if it isn't announced or the wrong one is announced. The graces still go to those souls listed, but I'm sorry for any way that these mistakes have hurt your feelings, especially if you came to the Mass expecting the intention to be said out loud for your loved ones.

In addition, we are supposed to limit Mass intentions to one per Mass (that is, one \$10 offering per Mass). I'm sorry for the limited number of Masses available for your loved ones as a result of following this rule established by Canon Law!

Because of the number of intentions we have received, the rest of this calendar year is already full.

Moving forward, we will need to limit Mass intentions to 3 per family (and only one of those being a Sunday Mass) so that everyone can have the opportunity to have Masses said for their loved ones.

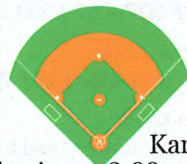

Addressing My Anxious Life

Causes of Anxiety	Action Steps for Peace
I believe everything in my life depends on me	Begin the day with the Novena of Surrender
I am burdened by the <u>guilt</u> of my mistakes or the weight of my weaknesses	Bring your failings to confession monthly
I am putting my wants and comforts at the center of my life	*Make an extra effort to go to daily Mass, which always involves self-sacrifice *Reach out to or serve someone who you know could use the help
I am <u>overwhelmed</u> with exposure to difficult people or circumstances	Spend a half hour, daily if possible, in front of the Eucharist in the church or the adoration chapel
I have too many thoughts to process at once or don't know how to approach a difficult situation/task	Commit to a daily rosary, bringing each thought as it comes to Jesus through Mary
I am feeling increasingly <u>isolated</u>	Schedule times for meals, coffee, or regular phone calls with family and friends
I believe I have to figure everything out myself, including the trajectory of rest of my life	Seek out a wise, spiritual friend or mother/father figure that can meet and help guide you monthly
I am distracted thru <u>hyperactivity</u> or too much <u>screen time</u>	*Screen-free down time, especially first and last thing in the day *Commit to reading an actual book for 20 minutes, especially right before bed (try The Chronicles of Narnia for starters :)
I am (we are) <u>overcommitted</u>	Opt out of renewing commitments for the next season that aren't actually required and that don't bring you joy
Feeding <u>comparison</u> and idle curiosity and scrolling with social media	Delete your personal social media accounts!
<u>Overexposure</u> to bad news that doesn't directly affect me and that I have no control over	*Limit digital news time to less than 15 minutes daily or have an email summary of news or actual paper delivered daily to stay current with the essentials *Focus on inviting God into your heart and sphere of influence where you can actually make a difference
I have too many choices when it comes to consumerism: clothes, groceries, media, home decor, etc	Find the things that are "good enough" for what is needed and stick with them so that you can give more attention to the more important decisions related to relationships and work

These relational, spiritual, and emotional factors are obviously in addition to the physiological factors like lack of good sleep, diet, exercise, and sunlight, and chemical/hormonal imbalances in the brain that may need additional medical attention
