One of the Best Gifts That I Can Receive as a Priest

Over the last year or so, I have been writing a handout called "How can I support my priest?" I started this project because I often get that question from generous, faithful people who want to see their priests thrive, especially in the midst of all of the demands and spiritual opposition that can come our way.

I am finding, however, that it's a bit challenging to write because not every priest desires the same things! Right now, my number one item in the list is this:

- 1. Show and express your desire for a deeper relationship with Jesus**
 - **This combats us feeling discouraged or like we are failing as spiritual leaders**
 - **Every parent desires to see their children thrive; likewise, the best gift you can give a spiritual father is to be faithful to your own life of prayer and relationship with God**
 - **How? Show up to Mass (even daily!), confession, and extra opportunities to grow**

I believe that most of us priests said "yes" to this vocation because we wanted to help people know God's love, so I'm pretty confident that this is one of the most important ways that you can support any one of us: taking your own relationship with God seriously!

I have been very encouraged in this last year to see more people coming to Mass (even daily!), going to confession consistently, stepping up to take weekly Eucharistic adoration slots, praying and reading the Bible more regularly, and participating in other faith-growing experiences...this is already the best gift you have given me!

This September, as I have mentioned at Mass, we will have two new opportunities for weekly spiritual growth as a community.

1. Wednesday Adult Formation Nights

On Wednesdays during CCD from 7 to 8pm in the school cafeteria, I will be teaching anyone who wants to receive the formation that we give people wanting to join the church in OCIA.

I'm excited to have this chance to grow together in hearing God's voice, getting into Scripture, and learning more about the basics of our faith that we never learned or that we easily take for granted.

This is open to anyone, seniors in high school and older, from any parish, and you can come and go week to week as you are able. No cost or commitment to come every week!

2. Encounter School of Ministry

This is a larger commitment of time and money to grow more intentionally in your relationship with God through the power of the Holy Spirit. You will learn how to recognize His Voice more clearly and grow in your capacity to get out of your comfort zone regularly to do whatever God is asking you to do, without letting fear get the best of you!

This will entail listening to about 2 hours of pre-recorded (very high quality) teachings throughout the week, and then on Sundays from 6:30 to 8:30pm starting September 13, we will gather for some praise and worship (open to the whole community), small group discussion on that week's material, and praying for each other according to the topic of the week.

You can sign up and try the first three weeks of class without paying, and if it's not for you, you don't have to continue! I did Year 1 of the school (there are up to 3 years) a few years ago, and it hugely blessed my priesthood and relationship with God, even after doing 7 years of seminary!
