The Year of St. Francis!

On October 4th, the Church will celebrate the 800th anniversary of St. Francis' death in Assisi, Italy in 1226. For this reason, Pope Leo declared this year to be officially the "Year of St. Francis."

I love that St. Francis is represented in one of our church's beautiful stained glass windows because he is one of my top three favorite saints. His joy and radical obedience in following Jesus and whatever He asks is a constant inspiration for me.

Most people are aware that he is the patron of animals because of his great love of all God's creation and his seeming ability to communicate with them, but perhaps we aren't aware of some of the other amazing things about this saint who had a gigantic impact on the history of the Church.

In addition to some interesting facts below, I would encourage you to read two of my favorite books on his life:

1. **The Joyful Beggar** by Louis De Wohl (historical fiction but still quite accurate and very inspiring for all ages!)
2. **My God and My All** by Elizabeth Gouge (non-fiction that gives an amazing look into Francis' "interior life")

Other important facts about St. Francis:

1. He was the first saint to receive the "**stigmata**" or the wounds of Jesus in his hands, feet, and side
2. He originated the idea of reproducing the "**Nativity Scene**" with live animals in a stable
3. He renounced the wealth of his family to live in **radical poverty**.
4. His followers multiplied exponentially and their example of living in radical poverty and dependence on Divine Providence brought **spiritual renewal to the Church** that was plagued with corruption, ignorance, and wealth among clerics and the hierarchy.
5. Pope Innocent III was hesitant to give approval to Francis' new community, but he was **convinced by a dream** where he saw a poor man in a rough habit physically supporting the Cathedral of Rome
6. At the obvious risk of his life, St. Francis directly **confronting the Muslim Sultan Al-Kamil** and challenged his religious leaders to jump into a fire with him to prove the truth of Christianity. The Sultan was so impressed with his boldness that he allowed Francis and his followers to preach and maintain religious sites in the Holy Land.
7. If you visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Angels which was built around the chapel that served as the first headquarters for Francis and his followers, there is a statue of St. Francis indoors that is constantly occupied by doves. When one leaves, another flies in the window to take its place....it's an amazing sight!
